

Heron Habitat Helpers Accomplishments –2004

- **Completed 75% of major habitat restoration with volunteers on 1 acre of the Kiwanis Wildlife Corridor with a \$10K Wild Places in City Spaces Grant from King County. Monitoring and maintenance continue.**
- **Contracted with Earth Corps, which undertook 1 ½ acres of ravine restoration under a \$37K Large Grant from Seattle's Dept. of Neighborhoods. Project surveyed by the Seattle Urban Nature Project.**
- **Awarded a \$50K Large Grant from Seattle's Dept. of Neighborhoods, work to be conducted in Fall 2005.**
- **Held a third year Birthday Party attended by about 80 people, including a Seattle councilman. Held annual meeting to elect officers.**
- **Conducted approximately 26 work parties for volunteers. Conducted tours for City and County officials during some of these work party events. Also, sponsored coffee parties and lemonade stands.**
- **Worked with Seattle Public Utilities to achieve a wetlands delineation map for Kiwanis Ravine – containing 1.1 acres of wetland in 11 discrete areas.**
- **Worked with Sound Transit to develop a proposal for mitigating wetlands for its Golden Gardens rail project by restoring wetlands in Kiwanis Ravine's A, B, C wetland areas. Project awaits approval.**
- **Held two summer fundraiser house parties, to build our General Fund to assist when Grants run short and pay for ongoing publicity.**
