

Heron Habitat Helpers Accomplishments – 2006

- **Completed year 4 of volunteer restoration at Kiwanis Ravine Overlook.**
- **Wrapped up year 3 of volunteer restoration work at Kiwanis Wildlife Corridor by finishing our \$10K King County grant and beginning a \$15,000 Small and Simple Grant from Seattle's Department of Neighborhoods.**
- **Began year 1 of our Aquatic Habitat Grant from Seattle Public Utilities. \$37,350 will take this West Fork work through 2010, under EarthCorps.**
- **Began year 1 of the \$30,000 East Fork Rooftop Mitigation Project with funds contributed by a developer, and continued restoration work in the steep ravine of Central Kiwanis, all under contract with EarthCorps.**
- **Worked with Sound Transit and its contractor, EarthCorps, to initiate its 5-year wetlands mitigation project in Kiwanis Ravine's wetlands.**
- **Held a fifth birthday Party attended by about 150 people, this year at Daybreak Star in cooperation with United Indians of All Tribes. Held annual meeting to elect officer and our second annual planning retreat.**
- **Conducted 23 work parties for volunteers. Conducted tours for City officials. Also sponsored coffee parties, an educational evening with Seattle Audubon, tables at various events, and “Henry the Heron” in the Magnolia Seafair Parade.**
- **Expanded public consciousness raising regarding the potential of daylighting Wolfe Creek to public agencies, bringing all affected public agencies and tribes to the table along with HHH and its partners.**
- **Held one summer fundraiser – an ice cream social – to build our General Fund to assist when Grants run short and pay for ongoing publicity. Continued to build our restricted fund providing long term endowment.**
