

Heron Habitat Helpers Accomplishments – 2007

- **Completed year 5 of volunteer restoration at Kiwanis Ravine Overlook.**
- **Completed year 4 of volunteer restoration work at Kiwanis Wildlife Corridor by completing a \$15,000 Small and Simple Grant from Seattle's Department of Neighborhoods.**
- **Won a year 2 \$70,000 Aquatic Habitat Grant and conducted our second year of restoration along the steep slopes of Wolfe Creek, south of Fort Street, under contract with EarthCorps.**
- **Began the East Fork Rooftop Mitigation Project, funded by the 3150 W. Government Way developer, and completed year 1 of restoration with assistance of EarthCorps.**
- **Continued working with Sound Transit and its partner EarthCorps for its wetlands mitigation work in the north half of the ravine.**
- **Held a sixth Birthday Party attended by about 75 people at the Discover Park Visitor Center. Introduced a “Heron Jeopardy” game to attendees. Conducted a separate annual meeting and tour of the ravine for members.**
- **Conducted 20 work parties for volunteers. Led tour for City officials. Also, sponsored “tables” at various events and “Henry the Heron” in the Magnolia Seafair Parade.**
- **Continued meeting quarterly with agencies and interested groups to study daylighting Wolfe Creek through Commodore Park. Received a \$15,000 grant from the Russell Family Foundation to fund a white paper on feasibility issues.**
- **Used a premium membership – with an HHH image tote bag as the prize – as the main fundraiser this year to build the general fund for on-going non-grants expenses. Continued building our long term endowment.**
